The Great Forest Park Balloon Race (GFPBR), presented by PNC Bank, is one of the longest running hot air balloon races in the country, and one of the only that takes place in a large metropolitan city. The tradition began in 1973 with a handful of hot air balloons and a few spectators. Now an internationally renowned event, GFPBR welcomes more than 50 of the nation's best hot air balloon pilots and thousands of spectators annually.

Attendance reaches 100,000+ during the event weekend: an estimated 80,000+ attend the Friday night Balloon Glow, and Saturday's Hare-and-Hound-style balloon race welcomes more than 35,000 to the launch field & festival. The beautiful hot air balloons continue their impact in the sky, wowing hundreds of thousands more across the St. Louis area as they soar above the horizon.



Community Support & Contributions

The Great Forest Park Balloon Race (GFPBR) and related activities directly and indirectly raise more than \$175,000 annually for local charities, the St. Louis City Department of Parks, Recreation and Forestry and the City of St. Louis.



Supporting Homeless Animals with The Humane Society of Missouri

Each year, during the GFPBR weekend, some of the best seats in the house can be found on Friday night at the Humane Society of Missouri's (HSMO) "Glow in the Park" event. This exclusive event allows HSMO to host St. Louis dignitaries, friends and donors for a one-of-a-kind evening - raising more than \$100,000 annually.

Proceeds from the evening benefit the Humane Society's Animal Cruelty Fund, which supports programs to investigate and prevent animal abuse, as well as provides treatment and care for the animals.



Providing funding for unserved youth sports with the St. Louis Police Athletic League (PAL).

The Great Forest Park Balloon Race is proud provide space to PAL and the St. Louis City Parks Department to support their annual fundraising efforts.

In conjunction with the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department (SLMPD) and the St. Louis community, PAL funds more than 40 teams consisting of an average of 850 youth annually. PAL provides a positive and constructive environment through sports and activities for St. Louis youth to grow and develop, keep them safe, and ensure that they choose a positive path for their future.



THE GLOW

Forest Park will be abuzz with excitement in preparation for the Balloon Glow when dozens of hot air balloons will inflate and glow like giant lanterns. The balloons are accompanied by a variety of fun from our sponsors, inflatable activities, games, food trucks, other concessions and music. Weather permitting, guests are invited to walk among the balloons and meet the world-class pilots. The night's finale includes an incredible showcase from the U.S. Army Golden Knights Parachute Team and the PNC Bank fireworks display – the fantastic way to celebrate a truly spectacular evening.



RACE DAY

On Saturday, more than 50 beautiful hot air balloons will launch from Central Fields and fly across the St. Louis skyline. Central Fields opens at 1 PM with festival foods, a variety of fun from our sponsors, inflatable activities, games plus music and performances on the event mainstage. The U.S. Army Golden Knights Parachute Team will help kick off opening ceremonies as the pilots prepare for the 51st annual Race!

WHERE WILL THEY LAND? It depends on the wind conditions on the day of the Race. GFPBR pilots love to wave hello to spectators all across the St. Louis Metropolitan Area.

HOW IS THE WINNER DETERMINED? Unlike a traditional race, GFPBR is not based on speed. It is a hare-and-hound-style race. The beautiful PNC Bank hot air balloon named "Bank on It" is the "Hare" and leads the pack, getting a head start and landing first. The other balloons, called "Hounds" launch in waves shortly after in pursuit of the "Hare" balloon. Once the Hare balloon lands, the pilot and crew lay an "X" out on the ground as a target. The pilot who drops their birdseed/bean bag nearest the center of the target is the winner!

A Beloved Tradition

The race, which celebrated it's 50th year in 2022, is widely considered one of the best in the country – it was even inducted into the Library of Congress and honored as a “Local Legacy” in 2000. But the event started as a small affair in 1973, featuring just seven balloons and about a dozen spectators on Cricket Field in the northern edge of Forest Park. Since then, it’s grown to new heights. And, there's so much joy around these balloons – from the grandparent introducing their grandchildren to an event they've been attending for years, to a group of friends, or a couple on their first date, GFPBR brings smiles, "wow" moments, new experiences and memories that last a lifetime.
